What is the UNCRC?

UNCRC stands for the United Nations Convention on the Rights of a Child.

It was created by UNICEF and it has 54 articles which outline all the rights of the child. It builds on basic entitlements, such as the right to:

- Survival
- Develop to the fullest
- Protection from harmful influences, abuse and exploitation
- Participate fully in family, cultural and social life

There are four main core principals to our work:

- Non discrimination
- Devotion to the best interests of the child
- A right to life, survival and development
- Respect for the views of children

At Jakeman Nursery School we are here to welcome, support and listen. We aim to provide a range of services to create better outcomes for all children and families in our local community. Our whole school is focused on helping in any way it can. Our doors are open to everyone and particularly, of course, to every child.
